NOTICE OF VACANCY

SUPERINTENDENT

The Alabama Youth Services Board, acting in its capacity as the Board of Education for the Alabama Department of Youth Services School District ("Board"), hereby gives notice of a vacancy in the position of Superintendent of the Department of Youth Services School District pursuant to § 16-60-111.9, Code of Alabama 1975.

The current Superintendent has announced her retirement effective August 31, 2026.

Pursuant to Alabama law, the Superintendent serves at the will and pleasure of the Executive Director of the Alabama Department of Youth Services. Following the effective date of the retirement, it is the intent of the Executive Director to recommend that the Board appoint an Interim Superintendent on a temporary basis pursuant to § 16-60-111.9(d)(1), while the Board conducts a comprehensive search for a permanent Superintendent.

This Notice of Vacancy shall remain posted until the permanent Superintendent position is filled.

POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Superintendent is the chief executive officer of the Department of Youth Services School District and is responsible for the administration and operation of the School District in accordance with applicable federal and state law, policies adopted by the Alabama Youth Services Board, and the lawful directives of the Executive Director of the Alabama Department of Youth Services.

The Superintendent is responsible for:

- administering all educational programs operated by the School District;

- implementing policies adopted by the Board;
 - supervising instructional, administrative, and support personnel;
 - overseeing curriculum, instruction, assessment, accreditation, special education, career and technical education, and student services;
 - preparing and administering the School District budget;
 - ensuring compliance with applicable federal and state laws and regulations;
 - promoting continuous school improvement and student achievement; and
 - performing such additional duties as may be assigned by law, the Board, or the Executive Director.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must possess:

- At least a master's degree from an accredited college or university.
- Eligibility for, or possession of, the appropriate certification to serve as a superintendent in Alabama, an Alabama Superintendent Certificate or other certification required by Alabama law.
- A minimum of ten (10) years of successful educational leadership or administrative experience, with at least five (5) years of that experience occurring within the past five years.
- Demonstrated experience in instructional leadership, personnel management, budgeting, and organizational administration.

Preferred qualifications include:

- An earned doctorate in education from an accredited institution.
 - Experience in juvenile justice education, alternative education, or multi-campus educational administration.
 - Demonstrated success in strategic planning, school improvement, accreditation, and organizational leadership.

The Board anticipates conducting interviews following completion of the application period and selecting a permanent Superintendent within the time prescribed by Alabama law.

Incomplete applications may not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Board may utilize a search consultant or search committee to assist in recruitment, application review, reference checks, and related administrative functions.

Any consultant or committee serves solely in an advisory capacity. The Executive Director may make recommendations to the Board regarding interim and permanent appointments as provided by law. The Alabama Youth Services Board retains final authority to appoint the Superintendent.

Background investigations, verification of credentials, employment history, professional references, and other appropriate due diligence may be conducted before appointment.

Interviews and Board action shall be conducted in accordance with applicable provisions of Alabama law.
